



## 2011 Good Times Racing Series

- Sign in Fee: \$30.00 per car. Sign ins open at 8:00am and close at 9:00am.
- Track fuel must be purchased at the Chevron on Cleveland Ave., Madera across from the track entrance.
- There are 8 races in the series. There will be one throw out race.
- Pit Meeting @ 8:30 am
- Tires: After qualifying right side tires will be marked. Cars must compete on the marked tires in BOTH heat race and main event. In the event of a damaged tire the marked tire can be replaced by ONLY a used tire. (no new replacements) If the tire is replaced prior to that event the penalty will be starting at the back of the field. Tires may be changed for lower mains. Must start main event on marked tires.

### Format for all Races

- PRACTICE: One round - 5 minutes Practice (max 7 cars)
- QUALIFYING: Qualifying numbers will be assigned; order will be determined by a pill draw. It will be 10 lap warm up and 3 on the clock.
- HEATS: One 20 lap Heat race. Line up inverted from qualifying, If more than a full field, then 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, etc will be in first heat, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> etc. will be in the second heat. \*if 3 Heats 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> etc will be in first heat, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> in the second heat, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> are in the third heat).
- MAINS: Main event line ups will be inverted from the Heat Race Finish. If there are 2 heats then top 3 (JRS), top4 (SRS) finishers from each heat will transfer to the A main. (If 3 heats, top 2 transfer in all classes.) Same place finishers in Heats line up position determined by Qualifying time, faster time behind slower time.)
  - Novice: 25 Laps
  - Juniors: 30 Laps
  - Seniors: 40 Laps
- LOWER MAINS: 15/20/30 Lap lower mains start straight up from heat race finish. Same place finishers from Heats line up by Qualifying time, faster time ahead of slower time.
- All cars will be given maximum 8 courtesy laps for repairs, courtesy laps to be allowed one time per race.
- Race Day awards issued to all finishers.
- Novice drivers and Jr. Stock/Honda drivers can transfer to another class due to novice graduation or age and carry at most 1 point less than last place with the same number of races.

### 2011 Race Day Awards

- All Novice Finishers in Main Event.
- All other classes 1-3 Main Event Finishers

### Year End Awards

- Driver must be a Full/Associate member of Good Times QMA

- Driver must race in 6 out of 8 club races to be eligible for Championship Awards.
- Novice drivers will be eligible for a Good Times Series Participation award if they participate in 50% of the racing series after the driver's graduation from novice training.
- In order to receive points, member must be paid and in good standing prior to start of race day. Only points earned after paid membership will be counted.
